Spring and Autumn that a farmers
wife has more work to do. This last
week I have been dusting my rooms and
carpets and putting them down for the
winter we have hands hiring there will
be several more come out wack to gather com

I have no help now the girl that stayed
with me during the summer wanted to go
to school this winter by her doing my
washing every week I can manage the
other work very well

It is raining here to day and our
little village seems quiet but if to
morrow is a nice day they will make up
for their quietness to day they are going
to have a grand rally to morrow they
say our Polynya band has been kept
busy for the past three weeks playing

successful in learning to swim for
I think it is so nice

Nora if you were not teaching I would
try to persuade you to come with that
Lady & Gentleman to visit the Eastern
states I do not think you would ever

I would not if you would come and
