I have not heard from Idaho directly for many months. Milton's family seems to be doing quite well.

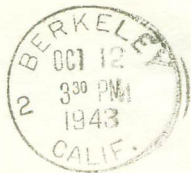
We had a victory garden at Milton's place & it was quite a little exercise.
