Archie told me of the horse back ride you had I hope you had a nice time I would like a ride but it is not much fun with out a saddle but I am a going to learn some way or other I wish your school was out so you could come up here I am nearly sick to see some of you up here. Ruth has just been up here and said for me to say she was up to preston all right. I have not time to write very much as it is post

time. Ray can walk pretty good  
now and would like to see his  
God-mother I am awful lonesome  
now with Archie gone. I am afraid  
I will nearly go up if some of you  
dont come. I wish Delia would  
come or little Henry or some one  
I dont think it would be any good  
wishing for Ma to come. It is quite  
a nice boy we have living here  
Brother Sharp up here had a boy  
seven years old hurt badly yesterday  
he was on a horse driving more horses  
his folks found him shortly after  
with his head all crushed in he  
can not speak. Ozo set up all night  
They sent for Dr. Ormsby he came  
and said he could do nothing for him  
It is blowing nearly all of the time  
Archie's folks are up here a good deal  
I should like to go down to Logan  
again if I could but dont know

when I can baby bothers so I can  
hardly write. You must write soon  
a good long letter you will have  
to excuse this for I am holding Ray  
and it is time to send it to the office
