I got your

all gone will be by Mo. I
will expect David to
come down to L. by the 22
23 or 4 & get you & take you
as far as Puster - & then
wait - till I tell you what day

to start - I will write him
this morning to that effect -
I think him to much of a
man to go back on his
word & leave me in this fix.
I will meet you at Soda
If he want bring you over
I cant come after you till
I have all of the crop in which
will take me 3 weeks or more
I want you here I have
had a hard time getting here
& have made arrangements
for David to come & it will
put me out off if he does
not come I think when
I write to him he will bring
you as far as Soda any
how That is if you
can stand it - If you think
you cant you had not
better try it Now David
want you to take good care

of yourself & not work
so hard. I am going to
see if I can get a carpenter
to work on the house this
morning it is getting so late
I must get some one to help
I think I will commence plowing
soon I have but little time to
write you as I have to write to
David so will close I am well
& feeling very good
