Lucy 4 weeks but Alvin was a way
from home the most of that time
and I had to fetch water from Shaffer

and water the garden and wash
after the girl left for Lucy wasent
very strong and I had to do my share
some times when I went to bed at
nights I would cry for I felt so bad
I am still living in the granary
but hope soon to have a house for
D D has got sum of the logs and is
gone for more you must excuse bad
writing for i am writing most of
this with baby in my arms for
must not show this to my husband
but give him my best respects to him
miss kiss the baby fore me
give my love to ~~D~~ Lucy Razey
I do feel so sorry for your
mother with grandma there it is
to hard on her to lift her and
water on her like she has to they
have to wash for her every day
