same fever the last that I heard

on the 21 of Oct I and I's birth  
day I have been down town once  
since you went away why did you  
not take that little stove I meant  
for you to take it for I should not  
use it this winter I do not know  
when Favell get my new rooms done  
now for there is no telling when the  
deps will be here again George has  
to go to Ogden on the 26 of this month  
for a witness It is getting late and  
I have another letter to write to night  
and I am tired for I have been  
washing I did not wash last week.

Logan Nov 16, 1886  
Dear Daughter

Nora I will  
try and answer your kind letter  
that we received yesterday I have  
waited not very patiently for a long  
time to get a letter from you  
I have had an envelope addressed  
for two weeks ready to write to  
you as soon as I got a letter  
you just think how you would  
feel if you was in my place  
and had raised a large family  
their have them marry and  
leave you and not think of  
you enough to write I guess  
you would that your Daughters  
could find a little time to write  
if they wanted to. The boys found  
the horses the next day after you

went home they was over in Lewiston  
I think your Dear little babe has  
a much nicer name than F. I would  
have had if you had named him  
what you said you would I wish I  
could see him and all of you within  
how much does he weigh I wrote three  
letters sunday and have three to  
write to night one to Mary one to  
you and one to Delia she (S) is  
well but was quite sick for a while  
you know she had a hard time  
when you was here and then when  
the Cars started she saw the  
degs jump on the train and  
it gave her a dreadful fright  
that with her hard work made her  
quite sick for a few days but  
they are all well now I do not  
know whether your Father will  
come there or not he ~~is~~ not at home  
just now Give my Love to Will  
and tell him that I wish he would

write some times I think he owes  
it to me for taking my Daughter  
away from me Now Roxie is  
married I have no one to help me  
and I have to sleep alone the  
most of the time I have had Ella  
stay with me nights for a while  
but it is too cold now and to much  
snow so I will not have her to come  
through the snow and cold for  
I expect to have to sleep alone  
now the most of the time so  
I might just as well get used to it  
first as last your Father thanks  
you and Will for your kindness  
in asking him to come and stay  
a while with you Willie Hodges has  
been very sick but is better he has  
had the ~~T~~ fever he was getting  
around all night until last sun-  
day he took with the camp and  
he came very near dying before  
they could get any thing to help him
