My Dear Star & Baby Wesley  
Your long looked  
for letter was recd this morning  
and I was so glad to get it -  
The news was most all pleasing  
and I am pleased with things  
It is just 2 WK & day since  
you brought me to the river &  
we have it raining here so I will  
not be able to get out I have  
been working real hard times are  
dull & prospects bad Boise  
R - is overflowing & drowning  
the farmers Frost has killed  
all of the fruit - that which the  
farmer depended most on for  
their money this fall & the country

has been canvassed though  
but I cant complain at my success  
I am doing moderately well

I had nearly 50 orders & will  
not be at work till 2 WK till Wed.  
Have not been in Boise yet  
will go there in a day or two had a  
letter from the S. Co. (my razor  
is there). Thanks. You were speaking  
about J. L. mortgaging the land in  
the field did you find out  
if he put it on our side I dont  
think he would dare do that  
but it is hard to tell what he would  
do seeing he is in the business now  
if he has I will look after it as soon  
as I come home I think all is  
well nowing that I owe but  
little on if any and it is having  
the statements I have at any  
rate Mr L. must straiten things  
before long that is all.
