Logan May 13th 1888
Dear Sister

I received your letter
a few days ago and can assure
you I was glad to hear from you
once more I have the toothache
again to day and dont know
if I can write as much as
I would like to.

You wished me to tell you
the Particulars about Aunt
Mary. Well she was going in
the Temple that week and
Thursday was fast today and
in the Temple she spoke in
tongues and they were interpreted
the meaning of which was
(in part) that here desire
was to spend the remainder

of her days for the Kingdom of
God. etc she went through the
Temple and finished her days
work and was about to return
home when she remarked how
curious she felt and how weak
so one of the sisters insisted on
coming home with her and
she talked as they came and when
they were on the dugroad and
Aunt Mary said she had not
got over the Spirit of tongues
yet. And the poor soul fell
in a paralytic stroke. from that
time she could never utter a
word. they brought her home
helpless and when we undressed
her and put her gown on
she was Stricken on the other
side and after that never moved
a particle except as the Parri
moved her and at 3:20 min

after 8 in the evening she died.
~~And~~ Just as we ^{returned} ~~were~~
from the Grave yard when we left
our aunt Uncle Lyman came.

Ma is some little
better but has the Dropsy
