

Logan April 8th 1893

Dear Nora

I was very glad to get your very welcome letter it found us as well as usual but very busy I get so tired that I cannot write nights I get so sleepy and then I generally have some one here sundays so I cannot write, my health is a good deal better than it was when I wrote last but I am never well I have to be so careful about catching cold for I am troubled with ~~gravel~~ I am so very sorry for Willie and Estella I wish you would all the particulars about the cause of her bad luck I am a fraid if she is not very careful she will be sickly

all her life I wish she could come
and go through the Temple I think
it would do her good. Clara I am
worried a bout Lydia she is so
very sick and her heart is affected
I am thinking of going up there
to Preston to see her if I can get
a pair of shoes and the money to go
with your Father just got home from
Salt Lake last night he said
that he had a grand time in the
Temple he was at the dedication
two days. Mary and her two boys
George John Rose and Sleyrum
are in Salt Lake now they
will go in the Temple tomorrow
and next day apart and then one
day and the rest the next
John and Rose and Sleyrum
have been gone a week tomorrow
Ozra and Ruth are going too

if they can leave Lydia

Your Father says that the Temple is the most beautiful place he ever saw he says our Temple is nowhere beside of Salt Lake Temple he (your Father) saw E. M. C. in Salt Lake he says Lydia is getting a long poorly his health is very poor he is not able to do much

I wish you would tell me when you are looking for a certain blessing from Heaven I wish you could be here with us we all would do all we could for you We have fine weather now the most of the time the snow is most all gone I had begun to think that winter would last all summer

Well I do not know as I can
think of any thing more to write
I must write to I fear Wesley
We all could read his letter
it seems curious that he reads
in the third reader

Well Nora I pray God to
bles you and yours with good
