I am beginning to get ready to handle a large crop this year Well I have sold the cattle and the old black cow weighed 1910# and went at \$3.50 Cwt, had some green fat I think she would have gone around 2500#, How are you coming along? I have always felt that you could take care of yourself but if anything comes up let me know and I will help you out I wrote Wesley about the money question and I suppose it covers your ground on the same question. I am glad you are doing well and will be glad when you are home next Spring, The lease I went into on the Sacres of onions is not a sure go yet, The old man seems quite cranky and I think will fall down YOU see I have a man working that has some knowledge of onion growing and he thinks we can make big money and it looks that way to me. I will begin the cleaning of the seed as soon as I get back from Boise and begin to shape up for the cropping season. and when you see the ranch again I hope you will see fine prospects. Well Fabian use your best judgement and make all out of your time you can. I am looking for some great changes in the near future and the man that is ready with the goods is the man that will win and you want to be there with the goods. Pigs Sheep Turkeys Chickens Geese and every thing else is looking well. Well I can't think of anything else to say so will close. We are all well and send our best wishes.
