I truly sympathize with you over the death of Mitchel had conditions been favorable and roads fit to travel the folks would have come to the funeral I at the time was to Eldon at Clearfield Utah.

The ^{first} telegram ^{came} at once to me but Eldon not having phone I did not get the word until the day he was buried at that time I was bed fast suffering the effects of light stroke and have not fully as yet recovered my blood ^{pressure} was over two hundred it dropped suddenly 170. I suffered a terrible ordeal but it has left me no bad effects perhaps if I had not put up such a fight its hard to tell what had been my fate.

conditions are getting favorable soon to start farm work I appreciate your letter Mammie telling about Mitchel accident that meet Los Angeles before it found me.

Its a question where to send this letter eventually it will find you. He will try to get togeth this summer in sympathy aunt Delia
