He will have to learn Portuguese, the official language, also Spanish and perhaps German. He had a splendid trip to Germany when he flew over to see Dale, etc. We were happy to have him home for 3 months - until he became 20 - They didn't want him to resign at West Point so he didn't get home until in August. He's been away so much that we really enjoyed having him with us.
